APCO Pro-CHRT Extends Outreach to Local Chapters by Bill Carrow

For the 2014-2015 committee year the APCO Pro-CHRT (Professional Communications Human Resource Committee) is mounting a campaign with the goal to see each chapter establish a chapter-level Pro-CHRT committee.

There are a multitude of issues that affect the performance of our telecommunicators on a daily basis, such as training certification, retirement benefits and recognition of the great jobs they perform.
